Pendleton Art Center Complex

HISTORY

The Pendleton Art Center complex comprises four buildings: the Warehouse, Annex, Studios @510 and 1321 Studios. The Warehouse was erected in 1909 for the Krohn-Fecheimer Shoe Company and was later purchased in the mid-1900s by Shillito's Department Stores. The Verdin Company, the world's oldest and largest bell and clock manufacturer, became the next owner of the warehouse. It's close proximity to the Verdin headquarters inspired Jim Verdin to reimagine the building. In September 1991, he re-opened the warehouse as the Pendleton Art Center, creating a downtown home to promote and showcase local artists. A decade later, due to the high demand for studio space, Jim purchased three surrounding buildings. Each building has its own unique character and guests are encouraged to visit them all. The Pendleton Art Center complex is home to more than 200 artists. The warehouse building has grown to be the largest collection of artists under one roof.
